Personal data is information that relates to an identified or identifiable natural person (hereinafter "data subject"); an identifiable natural person is one who is directly or indirectly identifiable, in particular by means of an association with an identifier such as a name, address or similar. This includes, for example: Name, email address and telephone number of the contact person and managing director. We process personal data exclusively within the legal framework, i.e. if the person concerned has given us their consent or if a legal basis allows us to do so.

The **purpose of processing** includes whatever is required to process the applicant procedure, in particular for communication in this context, or the fulfilment of legal obligations such as retention obligations under commercial law or tax law. The legal basis is the processing for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is a contracting party or for the performance of pre-contractual measures pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 b) GDPR or the legitimate interest pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 f) GDPR or the performance of a legal obligation pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 c) GDPR. Your personal data will be stored for as long as is required for the processing of the application. Your data will be deleted from our applicant database no later than six months after receipt of your application. Naturally, we will treat your information strictly confidentially and in accordance with the current data protection regulations.

No **automated decision-making** will take place. Personal data will not be passed on to third parties.

Data Security

We have set up technical and organisational security measures to protect personal data, in particular against loss, manipulation or unauthorised access. We regularly update our security measures to adapt to ongoing technical developments.

Rights of data subjects

Data subjects have the right to request information about their data free of charge at any time. If the data is incorrect, they have the right to have it rectified. If the data is wrongfully stored or if the data subject so wishes, they have the right to it being erased. If we have a duty to continue storing the data due to other legal obligations (for example, due to commercial or tax law), the data can be limited to certain processing operations so that it is only available to fulfil this legal purpose. In addition, there is the right to restrict processing and the right to data portability. There is a right to lodge a constraint to the Federal State Commissioner for Data Protection and Freedom of Information of Baden-Württemberg.
